A coin-operated deposit lock is a mechanical lock that is reserved by inserting a coin or token. It is often used for security compartments in specialist shops and shopping centres and releases the deposit at the end of use.

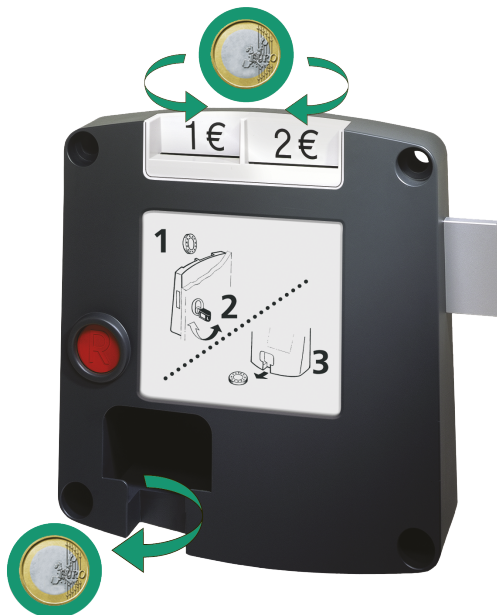
